Inside HyperFont

HyperFont is designed to **automatically digitize lettering** for embroidery. HyperFont has a **Wizard** that walks you through a step-by-step process for creating an **automatic** embroidery design. In this segment, each step and process will be defined.

Open Wizard



Step	Action	Result
>1	Select HyperFont from	HyperFont Wizard/Introduc-
	the Create drop-down menu.	tion page will open.
>2	Click Next .	

You must launch the Software (see section called "How to Open FUTURA) to use the HyperFont wizard.

>1: Enter Text

This is the step for typing in the lettering for embroidery and selecting a font style.

>1	Type Text in the Text box.

>1	Click Select in the Select	A list of fonts from Windows

>2	Choose a Font from the list.

>2: Embroidery Settings

In the 2nd step the Wizard is offering the option of two types of filling of the text. **"Fill Stitch"** - has only one stitch angle. This is a good choice for **large lettering**. **"Column Stitch"** is like "traditional lettering" with the columns filled with satin stitches.

ATTENTION: It is suggested when embroidering small letters that the needle thread tension be reduced.

It is always a good idea to sew a test sample on a swatch of fabric similar to that of the final project.
